Whilst we were all hoping His Divine body would recover we nonetheless had been partly prepared for this sad event by the unfavourable medical bulletins of the previous 28 days. It would seem that Swami had gently prepared us to accept His will and thus spared us the even greater shock of a sudden departure from His physical form.

From the time He entered hospital there has been, and continues to be, a massive devotional reaction from devotees in the UK with prayers, bhajans, chanting etc. This was repeated across the globe and in some areas mass prayerful processions have taken place some involving adherents of various faiths including Muslims, Christians and Sikhs.

We look forward to welcoming you on the day.


